'Social Science Week' was observed from 20th to 24th October, 2019. The classrooms became a hive of active learning with ardent students participating in variegated activities.




## HINDI WEEK




## AL HILAL MEDICAL CAMP

The School's Toastmasters' Club which provides a positive learning experience, through which students are empowered to develop leadership and communication skills resulting in improved self-confidence and personal growth.




## UDAAN CLASSES
