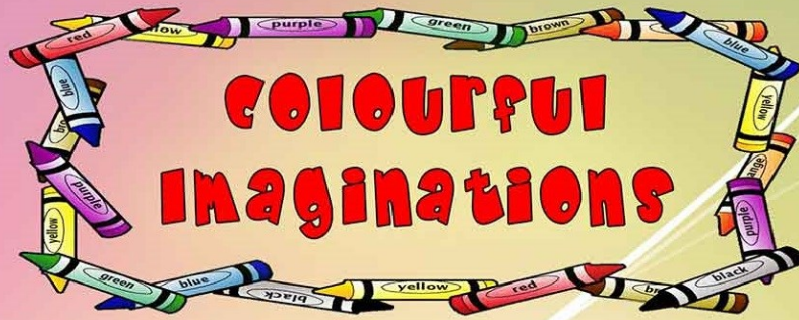

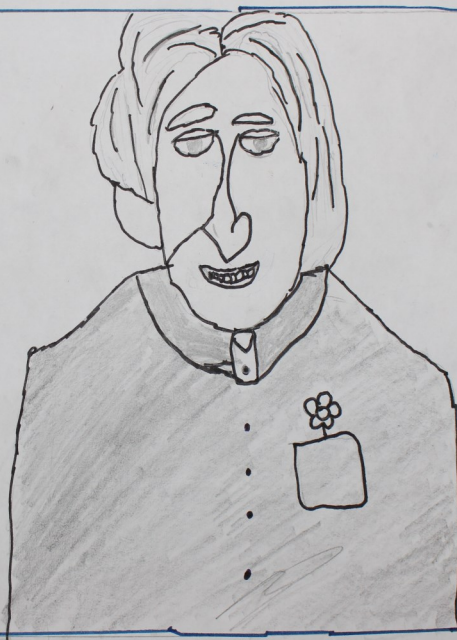
World student's day is celebrated on 15 October.

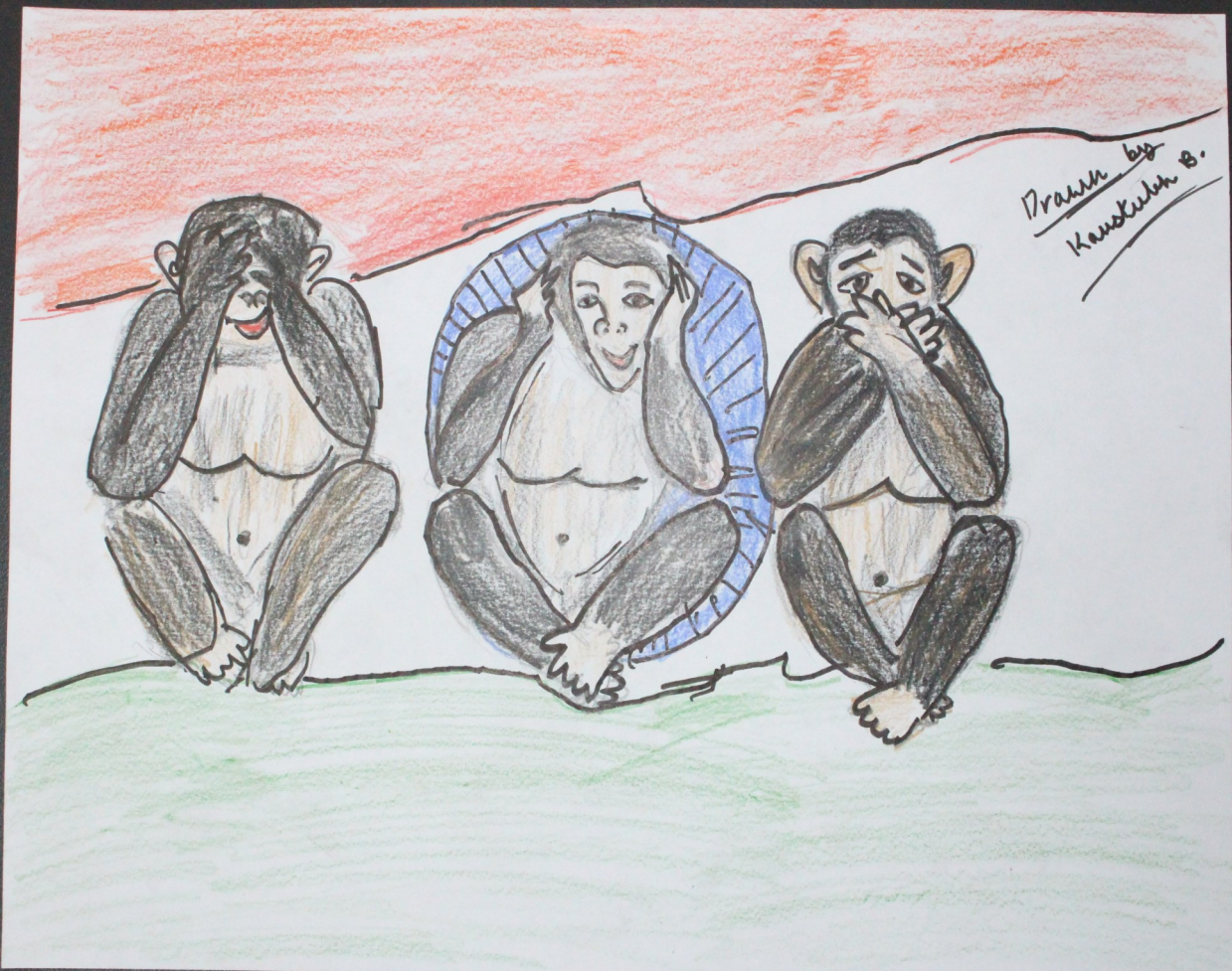

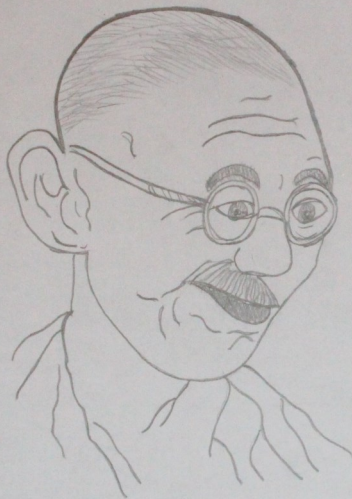
इनका जन्म २५ सितंबर 1916 को मथुरा में हुआ था। इनके पिता रेलवे में काम करते थे।
