




Editorial Note





Instruments used:

- 1. Two motors
- 2. Two light dependent resistors
- 3. Two transistors
- 4. One battery
- 5. Connecting wires (3 black and 3 red wires)
- Sensitivity adjustment resistors
- 7. Roller wheel
- 8. Screws

How to work with it:


1. Project the light on two light dependent resistors it move. If you need to change its direction front to reverse, alternate the wires of the motors.





