GUIDELINES, RULES AND REGULATIONS

Solo Dance Competition

In the preliminary round, dance may be presented in any form of style. The time duration will be 2 minutes. Students should bring their songs in a USB in MP3 format. Students can come in the School's Sports Uniform for the selection.

In the final round, Students should present the same dance on stage and the time limit will be 3 to 4 minutes.

For the final round, students will have to wear the proper costume, but it should be as per the dress code of the school.

The Song chosen should be appropriate for the school level.

Performance Category: Free Style.

<u>Judging Criteria</u>: Movement, Rhythm, Expression, Choreography, Overall presentation. Each one 10 marks.

Solo Music Competition

Pre-selection - Duration 2 minutes

Selected song and its lyrics should be appropriate for the school level. In the preliminary round the students will sing without the music but in the finals, students may use a karaoke track.

Time limit:

Preliminary round—2 minutes

Finals -3-4 minutes

The song should be sung in Hindi or English language only.

Style - Light music

Rap song is not allowed.

<u>Judging criteria</u> - Voice clarity, Vocal Expression, Rhythm, Pitch and Overall Performance. Each one 10 marks.

GUIDELINES FOR THE INVIGILATORS PRE BOARD-I EXAMINATIONS (GRADES X & XII) 2024-25

Dear Colleagues

As you are aware that the Pre Board -I Examinations for grades X & XII will commence from 1st December, 2024, we request you to kindly make the note of the following points.

Timings for the conduct of Pre Board-I Examinations and submission of Answer scripts

Reporting time: Normal school time

Distribution of Answer Sheets: 7:50 a.m

• Filling –up entries in the Answer Sheets by the students: 7:50 a.m - 8:00 a.m

Distribution of Question Paper: 7:55 a.m

Reading Time for Question Paper: 8:00 a. m - 8:15 a. m

Duration of Exam (writing time for the students): 8:15 a. m 11:15 a. m

Collection of Answer Sheets by the Invigilators: 11:15 a.m

• Submission of Answer sheets by Invigilators to Exam Dept.: by 11:20 a. m

• Venue for submission of Answer sheets : XI G

Instructions for Invigilators:

- 1. Invigilators are requested to be in their respective venues as soon as they report to the school in the morning.
- 2. Kindly follow the invigilation duty list displayed on the noticeboard.
- 3. Invigilators are requested to synchronize their watches as per the school watch for the smooth functioning of the examination. Please don't carry your mobile phones to the examination hall.
- 4. Please ensure the students are in perfect school uniform and wearing the ID card of the current session with their details mentioned on the same.
- 5. As the students will be filling the OMR sheet for the first time, you are requested to guide the students for filling the OMR sheet and check for any discrepancy.
- 6. Kindly inform about the name of the absentees to the Exam Dpt. /CRs latest by 8:00am.
- 7. Please inform the students to check for their pockets and belongings and ensure that they do not have any cheating material, mobiles or smart watch with them. This must be done before distribution of the answer sheets to the students.
- 8. For any doubt in Question paper, inform exam dept. member. Kindly note that it is not allowed to call the subject teacher directly for correction without prior approval from the office. Also, corrections should not be passed on through any message, e-mail, or phone calls.
- 9. Please sign the answer script/maps/graph paper/ continuations sheets after verifying all the details of the students.

- 10. Kindly note that the following activities / actions are strictly prohibited during the invigilation duty: Sitting, correcting papers, using mobile phone, working on system / reading, having food/ tea/ coffee, etc.
- 11. The students are allowed to leave only once to use the washroom and that record should be maintained in the sheet provided.
- 12. The invigilators are expected to be on round and keep constant vigil on the students.
- 13. In case of any UnFair Means (U.F.M) please report to the examination department immediately and the new Answer booklet will be issued by the Examination Dept. only.
- 14. Please ensure that students should not leave the exam room till all the papers have been collected, arranged as per roll number wise and grade wise.
- 15. Collection of the answer scripts will be done by respective invigilator as per the time mentioned above (*do not collect the papers before time*).
- 16. Handover the collected answer sheets to exam department as per the venues mentioned above. (All extra papers and other examination materials should also be handed over with the answer scripts).
- 17. Respective subject teachers should collect the answer scripts from the examination department on the same day.
- 18. Any staff member who is not on duty should not enter an examination room at any time during the examination to avoid disturbance. In case of urgency, please contact any of the examination team members.
- 19. Attendance sheet will be provided in each venue; invigilators should get it signed by the respective students on the day of exam. This sheet will also have a column of record for continuation sheets taken by the students. Kindly get it signed by them **each time** they ask for it.

Kindly follow the correction procedure:

- (i) The subject teachers should correct five papers (2-high achievers, 2-mediocres & 1-low achiever) of respective grade and discuss the correction with their respective HODs (kindly coordinate with your HOD for the same)
- (ii) The correction for the complete bundle of answer scripts must be done only after discussing with the HODs.
- (iii) The answer scripts must be cross checked (i.e. all questions are marked & tally the total marks) by the parallel respective subject teacher.
- (iv) The answer scripts should be given to the respective HOD for verification.
- (v) The corrected answer scripts should be shown to the students & papers should be discussed thoroughly for any doubt/ totaling error/ unmarked answer.
- (vi) The answer scripts should be handed over to the respective student after correction, if any.
- (vii) No change in the marks will be entertained once the answer sheet is handed over to the student by the teacher after the proper discussion of paper.
- (viii) The marks should be entered in the portal after the above-mentioned procedure.

Kindly follow the above instructions for the smooth process of Result Preparation.

PRE BOARD -I EXAMINATIONS (2024-25)

Dear parents and students

Kindly note the following points for the Pre Board- I Examinations

- Reporting time: Between 7:15 a.m. and 7:35 a.m.
- Distribution of Answer Sheets: 7:45 a.m
- Filling up entries in the OMR Sheets by the students: 7:50 a.m. to 8:00 a.m
- Distribution of Question Paper: 7:55 a.m
- Reading Time for Question Paper: 8:00 a.m. to 8:15 a.m
- Duration of Exam (writing time for the students): 8:15 a.m. to 11:15 a.m.
- Collection of Answer Sheets by the Invigilators : 11:15 a.m

GUIDELINES TO THE STUDENTS:

- 1. The students should be in perfect School Uniform (Sports Uniform is not allowed). Kindly note that if any student is not in perfect uniform, she / he will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- 2. The students should check the seating arrangement displayed on the notice board & report to their respective examination rooms on time.
- 3. Only permitted stationery items (pens, pencils, scale, geometry box) & transparent water bottles are allowed in the exam room. The stationery items must carry in a transparent pouch.
- 4. Use of any unfair means like carrying of study material in any form, mobile, electronic gadgets, digital/smart watch, etc. in the examination hall is strictly prohibited and will invite action as per the CBSE Examination code of conduct.
- 5. Except in case of medical emergency recommended by the doctor frequent visits to the washroom must be avoided.
- 6. The students may contact the invigilator in case of any doubt in the question paper.
- 7. The students are allowed to leave the exam room with the invigilator's permission only after all the answer sheets are collected by the invigilator.
